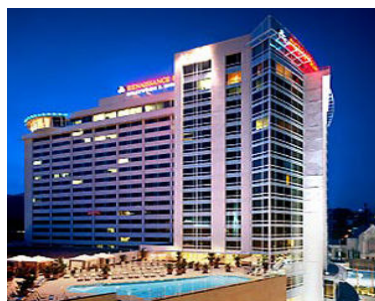

FAQs

What airport do I fly into and out of?

Your guide will pick you up from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) on your arrival day. Your flight should arrive no later than 1:00 p.m. At the end of your adventure, you will be transferred back to Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) or John Wayne International (SNA). You may schedule a departure flight for anytime after breakfast.

What is the climate like?

The Los Angeles area (which includes Anaheim) generally has dry, mild weather, with a greater chance of rain from January to March. October average temperatures: Highs in the mid 70s, lows in the mid 50s.

How strenuous are the activities?

While this adventure is not considered physically strenuous, most days will include one or more hours of walking. The days at the Disneyland® Park will require walking and standing in line; however there are opportunities to rest. While nearly all of the trip's featured activities are gentle if examined separately, the full range of activities requires a moderate amount of stamina in order to get the most of your vacation

What ages are appropriate for this adventure?

While we welcome children ages 4 and up at the time of travel, we highly recommend that children be at least 6 years old at the time of travel on our Backstage Magic trip. This is based on several factors, such as extended hours of daily activity programming, potential for extreme temperatures and amount of physical activity (e.g., walking) involved.

Are there height, and weight restrictions for certain activities?

Yes. Please note that certain rides and attractions have height restrictions.

Can I take photographs when we go behind the scenes?

Photography is restricted during certain parts of the trip. Restrictions on photography include, but are not limited to, the following venues: Walt Disney Imagineering, El Capitan Theater, Jimmy Kimmel, The Jim Henson Company Studio, Walt Disney Studios, Disneyland® Park and at Disney's California Adventure® Park. Please ask your Adventure Guides for opportunities where group photos may be arranged.
